### NO PHOTOGRAPHY AT ALL IS ALLOWED BACKSTAGE

Here are a few guidelines to help everyone during the forthcoming show. For some of you this maybe be the first time your child has been on stage. Just remember, everyone, even the older ones get nervous. Don't worry, we (The PTA) are here to help.

If your child is in one of the following dances they are in the prologue part of the show. All other dances are in the main show

BFF - (Mini Modern and Tap)

Motown Medley - (Babies Friday and Saturday)

Freak Flag - (Mini Acro)

Everybody Wants to be a Cat - (Pre-Primary Wednesday)

Jailhouse Rock - (Pre-Primary Saturday)

Just One Person - (Primary Tuesday and Primary Saturday - 11am)

Get Back up Again - (Primary Saturday - 12pm)

### DRESS REHEARSAL TIMES FOR PROLOGUE ONLY

- Monday 18th March - **ARRIVE** at 3:45pm (to start at 4pm)  
**COLLECT** at 5:30pm
- Tuesday 19th March - **ARRIVE** at 3:45pm (to start at 4pm)  
**COLLECT** at 5:30pm
- Please drop off and collect at the **HOSPITALITY DOOR**  
(down Gloucester Street, turn left into Seaton Place and it's the second double doors on the left, if you get to the stage door you have gone too far!!)
- Sign in/out procedures are the same as the performances (detailed below) and a chaperone will look after your child during the dress rehearsal.

## DRESS REHEARSALS TIMES FOR MAIN SHOW

- Monday 18th March - **ARRIVE** at 5:00pm (to start at 5:15pm)  
**COLLECT** at 9:30pm
- Tuesday 19th March - **ARRIVE** at 5:00pm (to start at 5:15pm)  
**COLLECT** at 9:30pm
- Arrive at the **STAGE DOOR** and follow the procedures below

Upper circle will not be in use during the dress rehearsals but you will be able to sit in the stalls at the back when not performing (as advised by chaperones). Sorry no parents will be allowed to stay and watch the dress rehearsal.

## ARRIVAL FOR SHOW PERFORMANCES FOR PROLOGUE

Arrive at **HOSPITALITY DOOR** at 6:30pm and 1:30pm Saturday Matinee.

- Come dressed in your costume as instructed by class teacher: *(If you are in 2 or more dances, please wear your first dance costume and bring other costumes in a clearly named zip up suit carrier.)*
- No prologue costumes can be left at The Opera House overnight.
- Hair and Make Up should be done as instructed *(if you have any problems please ask at the dress rehearsal and someone will help you.)*
- At the **Hospitality Door** you will be asked to sign your child in and then you must leave them with their chaperone. Please keep hold of their outdoor coats/fleece/cardigan and bring them when you collect.
- At the end of the 'Prologue' there will be a short interval. Your child **MUST** be **COLLECTED** at this point, as they will have finished dancing. For those not watching, this will be **approx 7:15pm or 2:15pm for the Saturday Matinee.**
- The chaperones will bring all the children to the same place as drop off (**Hospitality Door**) where you will need to sign your child out.

If you are watching the show you must collect your child in this short interval, but you **MUST** have purchased a ticket for your child at the box office before curtain up as they are **NOT** allowed to sit on your lap. Opera house rules not JAD. Kindly ensure that the coat they wear covers their costume whilst in the audience.

## ARRIVAL FOR PERFORMANCES FOR THE MAIN SHOW

- Arrive at the **STAGE DOOR** at **6:00pm** and **1:00pm** for Saturday Matinee

N.B. students in the senior modern group "On Broadway" should note that this dance will open the show and so it is imperative those dancing in this number arrive **promptly** at **6:00pm** and **1:00pm** on Saturday Matinee.

- At the stage door your child will be asked to sign in and then told which dressing room they are in.
- Once in their dressing rooms, all students **MUST** register again with their chaperones.

## AT THE END OF A PERFORMANCE

- Evening performances finish at 9.15pm
- Matinee performance finishes at 4.15pm. No one is permitted to stay between the matinee and evening performance on Saturday.
- All rubbish must be put in the bins provided. NO food left behind. ALL windows closed.
- ALL costumes/headdresses/accessories must be hung up on the rails provided.
- Any missing items must be reported to chaperone or PTA member.
- Students must sign out from the dressing room and the stage door entrance and wait to be collected by parent/guardian at the **STAGE DOOR**.

## COSTUMES

Please provide clearly labelled suit carrier for all costumes.

ALL costumes must be labelled.

- Provide a cardigan/fleece/dressing gown, that is also named, to be worn over costumes between dances. Slippers or similar if you have a routine with bare feet.
- No items of value are to be brought into the opera house (ipads and ipods etc) **Jersey Academy of Dancing and the Opera House will not accept responsibility for loss or damage.**
- N.B. please keep personal items to a minimum due to tight space in the dressing rooms.

## **FINALE COSTUME**

All students will be required to wear black leggings and the Neon Lights t-shirt they will be given. If you would like to buy JAD black leggings please email Selina admin@jad.ltd

## **SICKNESS**

In the event that your child experiences any vomiting or diarrhoea 24-48 hours before a performance, the guidelines are that the child will not be able to perform.

If your child is unwell and unable to perform, please text your daughter/sons name and dance to 07797 766 232 as soon as you are able to, before the performances so arrangements can be made.

## **GLASSES**

If your child wears glasses but is able to dance without them, they can be handed to their chaperones at the side of the stage whilst dancing and returned immediately afterwards. Of course we will not ask your child to perform without their glasses, however the stage lights do reflect on the lenses.

## **MEDICINES**

If your child needs an inhaler (EpiPen) or other, please hand it to the chaperone, a clearly marked inhaler (if possible to be left for the week). Please advise the chaperone if you are watching and advise them of your seat number so they can contact you if any problems.

## **FOOD AND DRINK**

Only bottled water is allowed in the dressing rooms.

Light sensible snacks are permitted.
